Along with our CHF education program, the patient may also be enrolled in our Telehealth program.

How Our Telehealth Program Works:

- Patients use the interactive system 2 minutes each day to monitor their vital signs and symptoms.
- Daily health information is then securely transmitted through a cellular network or a standard telephone line to the telemonitoring nurse to be analyzed.
- The Physician will then be contacted if the patient requires a change in his/her medication or treatment plan. If no change is required the patient can go about their daily living.
